**INVESTED MENTORS** Olympic, Paralympic, and elite athletes will engage your students with monthly video lessons and hold twice-yearly video chats. They are carefully selected, trained, and supported by our mentor coordinator.

**TEACHER SUPPORT** Our toolkit of professional development resources helps teachers bring Classroom Champions to life for their students and create measurable impact. A team of full-time education coordinators will work with your teachers to ensure that they get the most out of the program and are provided the support they need.

**PROFESSIONAL LEARNING NETWORK** Teachers connect with colleagues across the continent, participate in webinars and our vibrant internal website, and access online resources.

**PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION TOOLS** Resources are provided to integrate Classroom Champions with locally adopted curricula, and help with lesson planning.

**TOOLS TO ENGAGE FAMILIES** Monthly newsletters are provided, as well as invitations to attend mentor video chats and family nights, and opportunities to engage via social media.

**RESEARCH FRAMEWORK** We continually gather information, reflect on the impact of policies, programs, and practices, and make decisions based on available data.

**PARTNERSHIP IN JOINT FUNDRAISING** Our grant support team will provide resources needed for grant writing, and offer ideas for fundraising. Our development team will provide resources needed for grant writing and options for private and public funding possibilities.
